

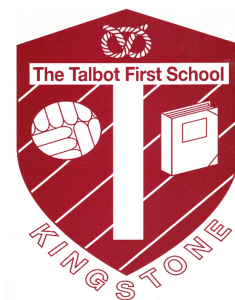

During the summer holidays we will be converting the area outside the hall into a Library area and the existing library will become a cloakroom. The Early Years class room and Class 1 will be redecorated.

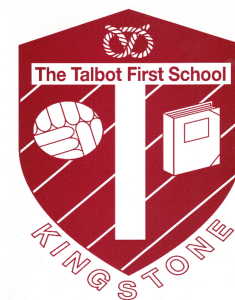
