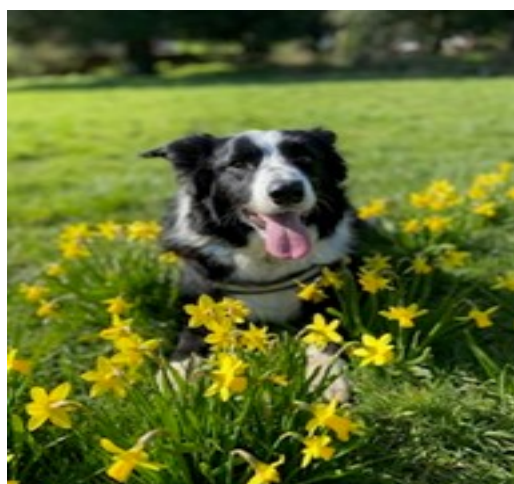
Buddy has enjoyed his days in school and loves the attention and having so many friends to play with!
