Thank you to all those people who came to the TSA meeting last night - it was a very productive meeting with lots of events planned to take place over the next academic year. The new TSA committee was also confirmed: Chairperson - Jo Ormiston, Vice Chair - Karen Edwards, Secretary - Caroline Dwyer, Treasurer - Jenny Norman, plus many other people happy to take a lead role in organising events.

This academic year the TSA have been asked by the school to raise money for 12 new laptops, which will be used by the children. The laptops that are currently being used are quite old, very slow and often don't work properly meaning that the quality of work that the children can do on them is limited. At the TSA meeting it was agreed that this would be the main focus for our fundraising this year whilst also still continuing to provide the children with fun events such as the end of year disco, a Christmas activity and the teddy bear's picnic.

Upcoming TSA fundraising events

Christmas Cards - the children will be designing their own Christmas card in school and will be bringing this home. You then have the option to turn their design into Christmas cards, wrapping paper, tags and thank you cards. Information about how to do this will be sent home with the design and the TSA will get a small percentage of each order from the company that will make the cards.

Christmas Fair - the Christmas fair will be at the village hall on Friday 24th November 8.30am - 11am. There will be a variety of stalls selling lots of different things (a good chance to get some Christmas presents or to treat yourself!), a raffle, the Christmas tree lucky dip (this has been very popular with the children before they go to into school!) and coffee/tea/cakes. Please let friends and family know about the Christmas fair so that we can get as many people supporting the event as possible.

Bag2School – you should have already received a Bag2School bag in your child's book bag. Please use bin bags if you have more than will fit into this bag. The more bags we fill, the more money we will raise. Filled bags should be brought to school by 9am on Tuesday 10^{th} October.

Christmas Shop - the Christmas shop will be back in school on Friday 8^{th} December. Tokens for the shop will be sold on the playground in the weeks leading up to this.
